

Installing Skype on Fedora 15

I've upgrade my Linux desktop a few days ago on Fedora 15 and tried to install Skype from the official rpms without any luck. All I've got is: *skype: error while loading shared libraries: libXss.so.1: cannot open shared object file: No such file or directory*

To solve the issue apart from the normal dependencies you will need to install the 32 library of qt4 along with a few more depending your already installed libraries. Each time that you receiving an error just try to satisfy the dependency:
